For each additional family member, add \$4,420 annually and \$368 monthly. Figures based on 100% of 2019 Federal Income Guidelines published in the Federal Register: February 1, 2019.		

Income guidelines for determining township assistance eligibility shall be based upon no less than 100% of the Federal Poverty Level as outlined above.

Jackson Township will use 120% of the Federal Poverty level as its guide in determining eligibility.

COUNTABLE INCOME - This term means a monetary amount either paid to an applicant or a member of an applicant's household not more than thirty (30) days before the date of application for Township Assistance, or accrued and legally available for withdrawal by an applicant or a member of an applicant's household at the time of application or not more than thirty (30) days after the date of application for Township Assistance.
