APPENDIX A Household Income

2025 Poverty guidelines for the 48 contiguous states and the District of Columbia

| Size of household | Monthly income | Annual income |

For families/households with more than 8 persons, add \$5,380 for each additional person.

Jackson Township, Hamilton County determines Township Assistance eligibility based upon the Federal Poverty Level as outlined above within range of 130%-150%. Income guidelines for determining township assistance eligibility shall be based upon no less than 100% of the Federal Poverty Level as outlined above.

COUNTABLE INCOME - This term means a monetary amount either paid to an applicant or a member of an applicant's household not more than thirty (30) days before the date of application for Township Assistance or accrued and legally available for withdrawal by an applicant or a member of an applicant's household at the time of application or not more than thirty (30) days after the date of application for Township Assistance.

Lump sum income (e.g. insurance settlements, tax refunds, grants/loans, etc.) will be examined for ability to pay for basic necessities exceeding a thirty (30) day period.
