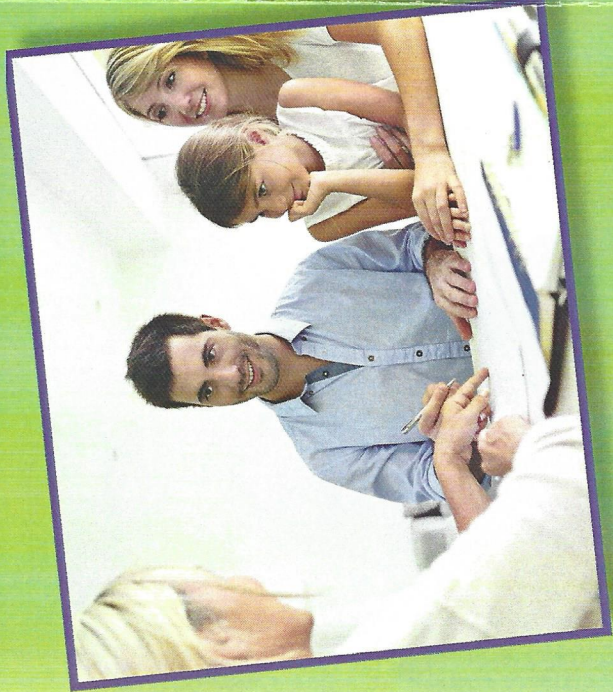


HAMILTON HEIGHTS Youth Assistance PROGRAM

Hamilton Heights Youth Assistance Program (HHYAP) serves youth ages 3-17 who live in the Hamilton Heights School district. HHYAP is a free and voluntary program. HHYAP works closely with the Hamilton Heights Schools to assist youth and families with the following:

-  Counseling for Youth and Families
-  Youth Anger Management Classes
-  Parenting Classes
-  Match Adult Mentors with Youth
-  Family/Youth Coordination of Services
-  Food and Clothing Assistance
-  Camp and Recreation Opportunities
-  Tutoring Assistance
-  Attendance and Truancy Support

- Other agencies

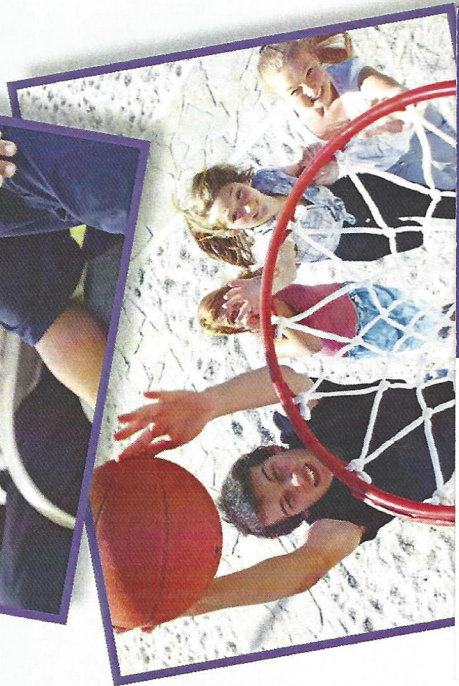

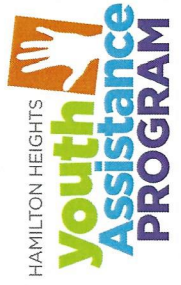
